Call for Abstracts - Electronic poster display and Trainee Poster Prize

The 2019 Australasian Gastrointestinal Pathology Society Annual Scientific Meeting Overseeing Committee invites all delegates to contribute to the scientific program by submitting abstracts for the ePoster (electronic poster) Display together with their full registration of the Presenting Author. (One full paid registration is required to accompany each abstract).

Topics: Any topic within gastrointestinal pathology, including hepatic pathology and gastroenterology, with a pathology slant.

A maximum of 2 abstracts per delegate will be accepted.

Abstract submission date: by 1st September

Abstracts for the ePoster Display may be submitted by consultants, registrars or medical students (please note, only trainees will be eligible for the AGPS Trainee Poster Oral Prize).

Delegates are responsible for providing the abstract to AGPS2019ASM@gmail.com

Abstracts will be considered by a subcommittee of the AGPS ASM.

Submission deadline is final.

Poster submission

If the delegate abstract is accepted, they will be invited to submit an ePoster (as single Powerpoint slide) which will be displayed during the annual scientific meeting.

The PowerPoint file must have the .ppt or .pptx suffix and should be less than 20MB.

Delegates are responsible for providing the PowerPoint file of their ePoster by email (AGPS2019ASM@gmail.com), with deadlines as follows:

- To enter the trainee oral poster prize: 1st October 2019
- For conference display only: 18th October 2019

AGPS Trainee Poster Oral Prize

The AGPS will award \$500 for the best oral presentation, with a \$250 runner-up prize.

The short listed posters will be judged, with the 2 best trainee posters selected for the trainee oral presentation, which will take place on Friday 25th October, with an 8 minute oral presentation at the AGPS annual scientific meeting.

Presenting authors must be present for the announcement of the winners on Saturday 26th October 2019 at Morning Tea to be eligible to win.

Abstracts not in the required format will not be accepted.

Abstracts must be submitted via email and attached in a Word document and not sent in the body of the email.

Abstracts must not exceed 200 words (excluding title, authors and institution, references and statement of originality).

Abstracts must be typed in English, using a 12 point single font with single line spacing, in Microsoft Word format.

Your heading must include: Your name (first name in full, followed by surname in full).

The title should be brief and explicit.

Underline the submitting/presenting author only. Do not include titles or degrees.

Underline the submitting/presenting author. use superscript numerals for author affiliations, and italicise the list of affiliations, e.g.

Harold Cook¹, Paul Stephens¹, Kate J. Davies¹, Garry Harding², Don W. Thomas¹

Specify the name and location of institution where the work was done.

Abstract may contain the aims of study, methods, results and discussion. If providing a structured abstract please put the headings in bold followed by a colon, e.g. **Background:** This study was conducted because..... **Methods:** The method used for this study.....

Abstracts in Case report format will be accepted.

Maximum of three references.

Abbreviations should be only used for common terms. For uncommon terms, the abbreviation should be given in brackets after the first full use of the word.

At the end of the abstract please include a statement specifying which part of the work was your own original idea and contribution (not included in word count).

No headers or footers.

Name your Word file in the following format: SURNAME_AGPS2019_ddmmyy

Abstract/s must be accompanied by full registration of the submitting/presenting author by 1st September 2019.

Note: One full paid registration is required to accompany each abstract. Abstracts without a paid registration will be withdrawn.

Once your abstract has been submitted, this is final. No additions or changes will be accepted.

As the posters will be displayed on the AGPS website, patient confidentiality is required, with de-identification recommended when appropriate

Committee reserve the right not to publish posters failing to meet confidentiality requirements

A confidentiality agreement and conflict of interest statement and waiver will need to be signed prior to publication on the website.
